# PRESBYTERY GRANTS POLICY

# **Purpose:**

- 1. To provide mission and education resources for
  - New, innovative ministry (including Mission Pilot Programs)
  - ♦ Education and Training
  - ♦ Children, youth, young adult and family ministry

to support individuals, agencies, schools and congregations/faith communities within the Presbytery of Tasmania.

2. To provide support for heritage listed property of the Presbytery of Tasmania

#### **Details:**

# **New, Innovative Ministry Fund**

### **Funds from:**

- ♦ Interest generated from Money For Mission Fund (including Presbytery IOMF)
- ♦ Mollie Chick Bequest: Free to allocate capital, annual report required to Presbytery
- Fraser Bequest: use of interest only, review 3 years, annual report required to Presbytery

# Purpose:

- Social research to develop new, innovative ministry
- ♦ Planning of new, innovative ministry
- sustainable and innovative first third of life initiatives
- new small faith communities
- new approaches to develop mission projects
- seed funding for new initiatives and new developments

## **Process:**

Go Grant: up to \$500 to small projects

- Complete Go Grant Form and send to Presbytery Office
- ◆ A Presbytery Minister, Treasurer and Chair of Resource and Development will assess according to above criteria- and inform of outcome within 48 hours
- Report on the impact and future directions of the ministry provided (see evaluation form)
- Acquittal required within two months
- One application per year/per body accepted

**Major projects** (Mission Motivated Development Form 1 - Getting Started and Form 2 – Discerning and Deciding provide useful guidelines)

- Work with a Presbytery Minister to develop application and evaluation form
- approval needed Presbytery Standing Committee and Treasurer
- ◆ allocation of up to \$20,000 per project per annum
- Report on the impact and future directions of the ministry provided within two months of project being completed (see evaluation form)
- Acquittal required within two months of project being completed
- one application per year/per body accepted.

**Pilot Programs** (Mission Motivated Development *Form 1 - Getting Started* and *Form 2 – Discerning and Deciding* provide useful guidelines)

 Such as Mission Catalyst Program or Children and Youth Program as Presbytery approves.

### **Education and Training Fund**

#### **Funds From:**

Davey St Fellowship, Knight Scholarship, Education and Training Fund

### Purpose:

Education and training for lay people and ministry workers and communities of faith. Including:

- ♦ travel assistance
- payment for courses and resources
- new, innovative ministry initiatives

#### **Process:**

# **Go Grant** up to \$500

- ◆ Complete Go Grant application form and send to Presbytery Office
- A Presbytery Minister, Treasurer and PRC chair will assess and notify of outcome within 48 hours
- Report on the impact of the education/training event provided (see evaluation form)
- Acquittal required within two months of project completion
- One application per year/per individual/body accepted

#### **Larger Amounts**

- Work with a Presbytery Minister to develop application which will take into consideration:
  - preferred 1/3, 1/3, 1/3 (presbytery, congregation/agency, individual/group)
  - How the study relates to enhancing ministry practice of group/individual and plan to apply insights of study to ministry context (evaluation)
  - Endorsement from governing body (i.e. church council, agency/school CEO)
- Send in application to Presbytery office for attention of PRC

- Report on the impact of the education/training event provided (see evaluation form)
- ♦ Acquittal required within two months of project completion
- One application per year/per body accepted.

# Children, Youth, Young Adults and Family Ministry

#### Funds from:

Campsite Fund, Rachel Millen Fund, Disadvantaged Campers Fund

## Purpose:

- Provide seeding money for CYYF ministry
- Provide camp subsidy for disadvantaged campers
- Resources and training for CYYF Ministry

#### **Process:**

Go Grant: up to \$500 to small projects

- ◆ Complete Go Grant Form and send to Presbytery Office
- ♦ A Presbytery Minister, Treasurer and Chair of Resource and Development will assess according to above criteria and inform of outcome within 48 hours
- Report on the impact and future directions of the ministry provided (see evaluation form)
- ♦ Acquittal required within two months
- One application per year/per body accepted

**Major projects** (Mission Motivated Development *Form 1 - Getting Started* and *Form 2 – Discerning and Deciding* provide useful guidelines)

- Work with a Presbytery Minister to develop application and evaluation form
- approval needed Presbytery Standing Committee and Treasurer

# **Tasmanian Heritage Fund**

Funds from: Property Sale Proceeds (PSPs) through the heritage building

#### **Purpose:**

- provide support for the responsible bodies of heritage properties to maintain properties with heritage requirements.
- preference given to responsible bodies with limited resources.

#### **Process:**

Go Grant: up to \$1000 for small projects

- ♦ Complete Go Grant Form and send to Presbytery Office
- A Presbytery Minister, Treasurer and Chair of Resource and Development will assess according to above criteria and inform of outcome within 48 hours

- Report on the impact and future directions of the ministry provided (see evaluation form)
- ♦ Acquittal required within two months
- ♦ One application per year/per body accepted

**Major projects** (Mission Motivated Development *Form 1 - Getting Started* and *Form 2 – Discerning and Deciding* provide useful guidelines)

- Work with a Presbytery Minister to develop application and evaluation form.
- approval needed by Resource and Development Committee
- ◆ Report on the impact and future directions of the ministry provided (see evaluation form)
- ◆ Acquittal required within two months of project completion
- one application per year/per body accepted.
